Things You or Your Clients Need to Think About Before You USE AI Technologies

- Do you/ your employees / your clients use AI platforms in the workplace?
- Do you know whether the AI platforms used are open or closed AI systems?
- Do you know the Privacy Policies, Terms of Use, Terms of Service, and Licensing Agreements associated with these Al Systems?
- Will the information you put into the AI Platform be used by the Platform? For what purposes?
  - Are you granting a license for Al Platforms to use your logos, trademark, artwork, writings, etc.
- ✓ Is the information you disclose to AI Platforms confidential?
  - In 2023, Samsung employees accidentally leaked trade secrets by using ChatGPT
- Have you used materials generated by AI platforms? In what ways?
  - Who owns the material produced by the AI platform? What contributions are yours? Can you claim ownership in what the AI platform produces?
  - Are you running the risk of infringing on the works of third parties (copyright, trademark)
    - Eight daily newspapers, including the New York Times, sued OpenAI and Microsoft, accusing them of copyright
      infringement. If what AI platforms produced was based on these materials and is substantially similar, there
      are risks.
- Al Platforms are known for hallucinations. Have you checked the accuracy of the materials that the Al platforms have produced?
- Do you rely on contractors to perform certain functions? Do you know if they use AI platforms to perform their work?
- Do you require disclosure when AI platforms are used either by you or your partners/vendors/contractors? OR AI platforms?
- Do you have an Al policy in place?
